







Typical Floor Plan

After going over those new condition of folding, we started to combine some of our first varied parameters. We found this stage very inspiring because, not only accosted the challenge of combination of the changes and conversion the different scales, but also appearing phenomenal curves and complex behavior was another important challenge of our studies. So we started to analyzing them. In this component we rotated the grids, so our curve behavior changed and we had a new structured option which was bending our curve from four sides.









In the first stage of design we started to manipulate our base component with just one initial parameter. scaling, moving, bending and gradient effects were the most important effect we involved in our design method. most of these effects used with vertex, edges and faces due to their behaviour.each of these component give us unique and particular preferences. After understanding the basic changble parameter in our initial component we began to explore hybrid deformations through adding two diffrent factors and exploring advance but also consistance changing in our design study. With thesse methos of design we can have a divers and comprehensive geometries than can contribute in our design method.



























By studying the complex behavior of curves , we found out an important behavior which was lelated to the special links of our cells . Actually , they were not put in order and were not aligned linear .So , in order to combine different patterns which had differentscales, we created aspecial joint. Again appeared a new resounding behavior in this stage . Actually after replacement of the joint , the mountain lines and valley lines reversed . So , we created a new level of complex curves, which was more predictable and really useful . Finally , we used this point to construct our final model.
